



Entry to the qualifying round is open to women amateur golfers who maintain a residence in Illinois and have an 18-hole handicap index of 22 or less and whose club or association is a member of the IWGA. A player whose club is not a member of the IWGA may elect to become an individual member of the IWGA for a cost of \$15 (see iwga.org home page).

Players for the qualifying round will be comprised of the applicants with the lowest 100 handicaps received by June 12, 2015 or until the qualifying field of 100 players is full. Confirmation of receipt of entry and payment will be posted at iwga.org. In the event of a full field, a waiting list will be established and posted at iwga.org.

The match play field will be comprised of the lowest 80 players from Tuesday's 18 hole qualifying round. Players who finish higher than 80th will be eliminated from the tournament. Championship flight will be comprised of 32 players with remaining flights comprised of 8 players each. The defending champion is exempt from qualifying and will be seeded number one. The defending champion may elect to play the qualifying round to compete for Medalist honors. Her seeding will not be affected. Ties for 80th place and for the last place in Championship Flight will be determined by sudden-death playoff. All other ties for flight

seeding will be determined by draw.

Prizes will be awarded to the winner and runner-up in all flights in addition to semi-finalists in **PRIZES** Championship Flight. Qualifying round prizes will be awarded for Medalist and Jr. Medalist.

> The entry fee is \$150 and includes a practice round, tournament rounds, tournament round warm-up balls and a \$35 voucher to be used to purchase food and other items at the host club. Refunds for cancellations prior to June 12 will have a \$10 administrative fee deducted. No refunds will be given after June 12.

A contestant may use a caddie, drive or have her caddie drive a motorized cart, or carry or CONTESTANTS pull her own clubs. Proper golf attire must be worn. Blue jeans, halter tops and tank tops are not permitted. Soft spikes only. Electronic devices that measure distance only will be

Registration will be available from 11 am to 3 pm on Monday, June 22. Players who do not REGISTRATION register on Monday are requested to register at least one hour prior to their tee time on Tuesday.



Entry is open to Illinois residents with a handicap of 40 or less, or a scoring average of 120 or less, who have not reached their 19th birthday and have not yet begun college.

Entries will be accepted from the applicants with the lowest handicaps until July 22. 2015 or until the field of 84 players is full. Confirmation of receipt of entry and payment will be posted at iwga.org. In the event of a full field, applicants will be notified if they

have been placed on the waiting list.

The championship will be determined by 36 holes of stroke play. Players will be flighted by gross score following the first round of play. Champion will be determined by

the low 2 day score regardless of flight. USGA rules will govern play and the IWGA Rules Committee will interpret and make all rules decisions. Electronic devices that

measure distance only will be permitted.

Prizes will be awarded to the top four finishers in each flight. Ties for overall Champion will be determined by sudden-death playoff. All other ties will be determined by scorecard playoff. All prizes will be awarded following play. The IWGA will not be responsible for sending prizes to contestants.

ENTRY FEE

The Entry Fee is \$75 and includes the two tournament rounds and prizes. No refunds

will be given after July 22.

CONTESTANTS

Proper golf attire must be worn. Blue jeans, halter tops and tank tops are not permitted. The use of caddies or automotive transportation is prohibited. A disabled contestant may petition the IWGA for an exception. Tournament check-in will be from 12:00 PM on Monday August 3 until 4:00 PM. Those unable to check-in on Monday must check-in

30 minutes prior to Tuesday's tee time,



ELIGIBILITY

Entry is open to women amateur golfers who have reached their 50th birthday by the first day of play and have an established USGA 18-hole handicap index of 30 or less. The contestant must maintain a residence in Illinois, and her club must be a member of the IWGA or a player whose club is not a member of the IWGA may elect to become an individual member of the IWGA for \$15 (see iwga.org home page).

ENTRY DEADLINE Entries will be accepted from the applicants with the lowest handicaps until August 15, 2015, or until the field of 120 players is full. The August 15 handicap index will be used to determine the final field and will be used for the tournament handicaps. All entries must be accompanied by a current handicap index card to assist the Board with determining the August15 handicap index for each player. Confirmation of receipt of entry and payment will be posted at iwga.org as well as the final field and waiting list in the event of a full field. Players on the waiting list will be notified by phone and/or email if they are in position to fill an opening.


